Key Points

What's covered?

- OneMusic Australia's music as Background Music is included for the areas declared in your POIAA Licence (this excludes our music used in any performance spaces or sporting areas).
- For an additional fee, you can also include the use of our music as Background Music in Dining Areas, in Car Parks, as Featured Music, as Website Use, for Music in the Workplace, Telephone Music on Hold and/or our Music Videos.

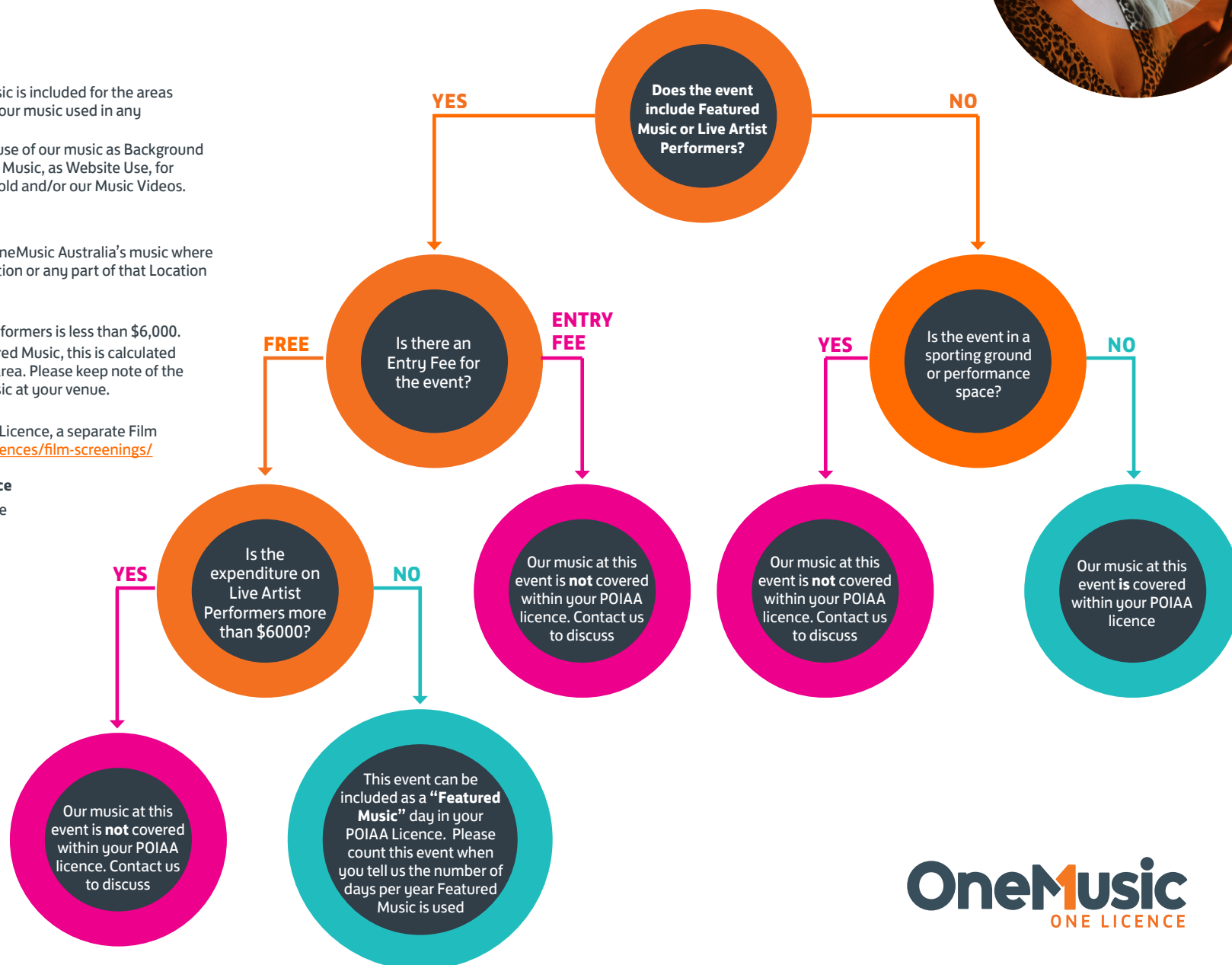
What is Featured Music?

- Featured Music in your POIAA licence means OneMusic Australia's music where it is given prominence as a feature of that Location or any part of that Location and where:
 - there is no Entry Fee to the event; and
 - the Gross Expenditure on any Live Artist Performers is less than \$6,000.
- If you use OneMusic Australia's music as Featured Music, this is calculated on per date rate, depending on the size of the area. Please keep note of the number of days per year you use Featured Music at your venue.

Film Screenings are not covered with your POIAA Licence, a separate Film Screening licence is required onemusic.com.au/licences/film-screenings/

If your event is not covered by your POIAA licence
